In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Thomas of Frederick County in the said Colony of Virginia being weak in Body but of sound and perfect Memory, Thanks be to the Almighty God for the same, and willing to record the circumstances of this present mortal life, and that it is appointed all men once to dye, but the death to come to Judgment; do make known this my last Will & Testament in writing, that after my decease my Body be buried in the Christian Buriall place of the said County, and my Soul to Almighty God my Creator who gave it me. I desire that I shall receive full pardon and full Remission of all my sins and be saved by the precious death & sacrifice of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ, and my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be Buried in decent and Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors after my decease. I give and bequeath my Goods & Estate with which it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give and bequeath the same as followeth.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son in Law Samuel Allen & his Wife one half of that Tract of Land that I purchased from Thomas Wilborn during their Natural lives and then after their Decease unto my Gran Son William Allen to him his heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John Tomfon one half of that Tract of Land that

Make a binding upon all persons to whom it shall come to perform
 from them to pay the same with my heirs & assigns my loving wife
 hereunto & assigns forever
 And I do hereby further contribute & assign my said loving wife Margaret and my son
 John Thomas Mills to being full & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, Revoking all
 other Testaments or Wills by me formerly made, & do ordain this being this to be my last
