& Testament in manner & form following That is to
Say First & principally I recommend my Soul into the
Hands of God that gave it & for my Body I recommend
it to the Earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of
my Executors hereafter named Nothing doubting but at
the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly
Estate which with it hath pleased God to bless me in this
Life I Leave & bequeath as followeth
Imprimis It is my will & I do Order that in the first
place all my just Debts be funeral Charges be paid and
discharged of them I Leave my present Dwelling plantation
to be Equally Divided between my 2 sons James & Jacob
Moon. Item I leave unto my son Richard Moon forty
Shillings current money. Item I leave unto my Daughter
Mary Moon a bright bay young mare aged about present
2 years as also I leave her six pounds current money
Item I leave unto my Daughter Rachael Moon a young
gray mare being this last springs Colt
Moreover it is my will & I do Order that

the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly
 Estate which hath pleased God to bless me in this
 Life I Leave & bequeath as followeth.
 Inasmuch as it is my will & I do Order that in the first
 place all my just Debts & funeral Charges be paid and
 discharged & then I Leave my present dwelling plantation
 to be Equally Divided betwixt my 2 sons James & Jacob
 Shullenger current money. I then I Leave unto my Daughter
 Mary Moore a bright bay young unmarried at present
 2 years or less I Leave the 1st part of current money
 from James into my Daughter Rachael Moore a young
 Gaily Mare being this last Springs Colt.
 Moreover it is my Will & I do Order that all the Creatures as
 Horses Mares & Cattle be sold except so many as shall be
 necessary to work the plantation & the money equally to be Divided
 amongst all the Children. And my Will is that the Creatures reserved
 of age. All the Rest & remainder of my Estate with all my
 Household Goods & moveables I Leave to be equally Divided
 amongst Rachael & my Will is that my 2 youngest Daughters
 of these three younger Children while single.

Lastly I Constitute make & Ordain my son James Moon & Henry
Thomas my son in Law as Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
and I Do hereby utterly Disallow Republish & Disavow all & every
other former Testaments Wills Legacies & Executors by writing my
name before this hereinafter written & Signed, testifying &
confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament.

November Anno Domini 1748.
