Item to Martha my wife I will that she has all my Estate my Debts & funeral being first paid except a horse Colt & huffer calf that I bequeath unto Joseph Dykes & them to be sold & the money to be put to Interest & to be for the use of the said Dykes when of Age.
Item I Do Will unto my three Sons Benjamin William and Jacob unto each of them One Shilling & to my Daughter One
