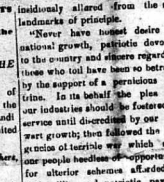

Our Platform.—We do not only believe that we are eminently qualified to fill the position of State Senator, but we make no bones of the fact that we are bumping ourself to secure the nomination for this district. 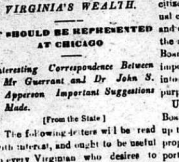
