of Body and of a disposing mind and memory do
make and ordain this my last will and testament
in manner and form following that is to say
After my just debts and funeral charges being first
payd I do order and give to my eldest Son Simon
Baub one dollar & to my Son Abram Baub one dollar
& to my Daughter Hannah now Wife to Thomas Brady
one dollar and I do hereby give to my three sons
William Baub Christen Baub Levy Horsey Baub
all my land in the County of Giles to them and their
heirs forever but the lands to be for the use of the family
until the youngest of my Children come of the age of
twenty one and then to be sold and equally divided among
my three sons viz William Christen & Levy Horsey Baub
and I do direct all my personal Estate to remain
in the hands of my beloved Wife viz Nancy Baub
until my youngest Child come to the age (or if she
should not live to that period then my personal estate
to be equally divided among my five daughters viz
Betsey Strayley Mary Baub Nancy D. Gately D.
Sally D. but the whole of my personal estate to remain
undisturbed in the hands of my Wife until my youngest
Child comes of age or until the death of my Wife which
in happens first therein an equal division of the whole
of my personal estate to take place among my Daughters
as aforementioned except my wife shall be at liberty to
give to my Daughters when they marry what she can
conveniently spare and the heirs to account for that
amount when she comes to the distribution and my beloved Wife
to have an equal share of my personal estate with my
daughters and I do order that my estate not to be appraised
nor sold but as appoint my beloved Wife my executrix

And my son William my executor & shall have
two shillings to dispose of my estates in the manner
hereby directed. The witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
12th day of June in the year of our Lord 1812
