

I Thomas Kirk of the County of Giles & State of Virginia
do make and ordain this my last will & Testament, in man-
ner and form following, viz:

First I will that immediately after my decease all my
all my personal property be sold as soon as may be. My
just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the amount
thereof and the remainder be equally divided among my
Children and Wife Eliza Kirk who shall be an equal
share with my Children.

Secondly I will that my half of the land bought &
occupied by myself & son in law Saml Duncan
continue to be occupied by sd Duncan upon his pay-
ing the sum of fifteen dollars yearly which shall be
appropriated to the benefit of the above named
until sd Duncan together with the Executors of this my
last will and Testament can or may sell the whole.

Thirdly at the valuation of the aforesaid land to be de-
termined by them, which sale shall take place as soon as the
sd land can be sold for the purpose of allowing the pay-
ment thereof to pay the whole sum, the said half of
which being the property of the sd Duncan the other
half shall be equally divided between my Children and
Wife whom I also make an equal share with in the
sale of my personal property.

Fourthly I Appoint my brother John Kirk & his child
to be my son in law to be the sole Executors & administrators
of this my last will and Testament. I do hereby make
known the portion herein bequeathed by me and obtained
by each of my Children & Wife & from the sale of my
personal & real estate as above named to be held by the
trustee or assignee as their own forever. In Witness whereof
