Reynolds of the County of Kenton & State aforesaid of the second part & Mr. H. Hendley the Guardian of Kenton County & State aforesaid of the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the S^r. Hezekiah Collins is justly indebted to the S^r. H. Hendley in the Sum of Eighty in dollar & forty four cents to be paid on the first day of March eighteen hundred and twenty two as by bond bearing date the Second day of March eighteen hundred and twenty one & becoming due on the first day of March eighteen hundred and twenty two which will more fully appear reference being had thereto which acts with the legal intent thereon concerning the S^r. Hezekiah Collins is willing and desires to secure to the S^r. H. Hendley - Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the premises & also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the S^r. Hezekiah Collins the debtor in hand paid by the S^r. Wm. Reynolds at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the S^r. Hezekiah Collins heath given granted bargained sold alien & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien & confirm to the S^r. Wm. Reynolds his heirs and assigns forever all his personal property (to wit) one Bay mare about five years old about 14 1/2 hands high three Bays one two years old heffer of James goodland Balow seven head of good Sheep one Saw & two pigs with all his household & kitchen furniture together with all his farming tools spinning wheel &c. on the plantation whereon the S^r. Collins now lives with all its singular tenements appertaining to the aforesaid property or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right title & interest of the S^r. Hezekiah Collins
