In the name of God Amen I cast myself
of the County of Giles and state of Virginia being
aged ana infirm of body but of sound mind &
disposin memory and calling unto mind the
mortality of my body and knowing it is app-
ointed for all men once to die do make consti-
ute and ordain this my last will and testam-
ent that is to say first ana principally I give
mine my soul into the hands of almighty
God who gave it ana my body to the same

to be buried in a decent christian like manner at the discretion of my executors not doubting but at the general resurrection of the quick and dead I shall receive the same again by the almighty power of god And touching such worldly estate where with it hath pleased god to bless me in this life I give bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner and so forth to wit —

1st I give and bequeath unto my dear beloved wife Sally all the property I acquire by my marriage with her to be at her own use and disposal I also give and bequeath to her for and during her natural life or widowhood one horse least valued at fifty dollars and a two ^{calves in part} ^{in weight} sheep and hogs the cow sheep & hogs to be of her own choosing out of my stockations of the house and ten acres of the tillable land in that plantation which is now her ~~the same~~ ^{now} to be apportioned to her by my executors hereafter named but in case my wife and my executors shalld disagree as to the manner which thirteen acres of land shalld be laid off the same is to be decided by two disinterested respectable men of the neighbourhood

2nd I give and bequeath unto my daughter French my Neg^e girl named Susan and her increase which she hath received and disposed of at her own will and pleasure which I consider to be her portion of my estate I therefore bequeath her nothing more

3rd I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Morgan my Neg^e girl named Eliza and all her increase which is to be her portion of my estate

4th Whereas I had given to my son Matthew French Straley on certain conditions my Neg^e girl Genny and her increase respecting which a controversy hath since arisen between him and myself which hath been settled by arbitrators I therefore bequeath to him my said Neg^e girl Genny and her increase but he is to have no other part of my estate either real or personal so I consider him alway literally provided for

5th Whereas I had given to my son Joseph Straley on certain conditions my Neg^e girl named Silvy and

her increase respecting which a controversy hath arisen between him and myself which hath been settled by arbitrators I therefore bequeath to him my said Neg^e girl Silvy and her increase but he is to have no other part of my estate either real or personal as I consider him literally provided for

6th whereas I have advanced to each of my sons James Straley and John Straley the sum of one hundred dollars to aid them in the purchase of land and a negro slave alike sum to my sons Daniel Charles Davis and Jacob L Straley I therefore give and bequeath unto my son Daniel Charles Davis and Jacob L Straley one hundred dollars each to be first paid to thentout of my estate to make them equal to each of my sons James Straley and John Straley my best debts being first satisfied however out of my estate 7th All the residue of my estate both real and personal which consists of this time principally of four tracts of land in this place being my former property to each other and his slaves to wit Jack Straley a stock of horses cattle sheep and hogs farming utensils and household and kitchen furniture & debts to me owing I give bequeath and devise to my six sons and their heirs forever to wit James Straley John Straley Daniel Straley Charles Straley George Straley Jacob L Straley to be equally divided amongst them with this exception only that my son James Straley is to have the liberty to take my Neg^e boy Ned out of the sum of three hundred dollars if he thinks proper to do so as part of the sum coming to him out of my estate but if the sum coming to him should not amount to three hundred dollars then on his paying such sum as with his share would amount to three hundred dollars he is to have Ned if he elects to do so

8th whereas my son Matthew French Straley and Joseph Straley are indebted to me by account besides the sum they are to pay me by the award of arbitrators about the sum six hundred dollars which sums if not paid to me in my lifetime are to be collected by my executors and equally divided between my six sons James Daniel Charles John Davis and Jacob L Straley to whom I hereby give and bequeath the same

9th I also give bequeath and devise that part of my estate to my wife for her life or widowhood
