with my children. Then I gave unto my wife one hun-
-dred and fifteen dollars which is the third part of the
money that Melch and David broy owe me and
after her death the balance is to be equal divided
with my children. She is not to destroy nor make
away with any thing of the estate willfully.
I then will all the rest of my property and
debts to my children to be equal divided
among them only saving Adam broy my
son I wish him to have what the law directs
I wish my daughter Sally to have her part
I then also do revoke disannul and make
void all other wills or testaments ever made before by me
this to be my last will and Testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this day and date above mentioned
Published pronounced and
orated this to be my last will and Testament

This last will and Testament of Jacob
Croy was presented in to Court and proven
by the oaths of James Straley and David
Hale and ordered to be put into David French's

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In the name of God Amen I Jeremiah Williams of the
County of Giles and State of Virginia being weak of body
but of perfect mind and memory do make this my
last will and Testament in the following manner and form.
First after the payment of my debts and
funeral expences I give my wife Mary Williams
and third part of my Estate both real and personal
during the term of her Natural life and after her
decease I give the same to my children hereafter
mentioned to be divided among them in the following
manner, Second I give to my Son Abram Williams
one dollar, 3rd To my Son John Williams one dollar
4th To my Son David Williams one dollar, 5th To my
Son in Law Randall Lucas one dollar, 6th To my son
Law John Rice one dollar, 7th To my Son Alexander
Williams one dollar, 8th To my Son Joshua Williams one dollar, 9th
To my Son Andrew Williams the following tract or parcel
of Land and bounds as followeth to wit, Beginning at
the old mill seat on a conditional line between him and
Joseph Williams and running thence with the same a
North course to a hemlock tree, thence with a fence
of mine a west course, thence a South course to
my line and with the same to Jacob Halls line
and with the same to Christians Smiths line
and with the same to a conditional line between
him and Randall Lucas and with the same to
Daniel Hollins and with the same to Joseph
Williams line and with the same to the old
mill seat, the beginning, 10th To my Son Joseph
Williams the following tract or parcel of Land
and bounds as followeth to wit, Beginning at the
old mill seat on a creek and running a north
course to the end of a knob of the mountain between
two broken branches of water and following the
said knob to my line, and with the same an
east course to the corner so as to join Randall
Lucas's old line and with a South course to the

Chesnut Thump near an old house where John Williams formerly lived there cropping a brick and running an East house to Collins corner and with the same Albert comes down a brick to Collins corner then to the beginning

to the my sons Hugh and James Williams, all and singular without any exceptions the residue of my land, 11th To Margaret and Rebecca Williams my Daughters all my perishable property (one horse excepted for James Williams my son) together with all my house hold furniture and kitchen furniture

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Sebastian Sweeney and George Wicorians my executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills or Testaments by me heretofore made and writing whereof I have heretofore set my hand and affixed my seal this 7th day of May 1819 signed sealed published and declared as and for the last will and testament of this above named Jeremiah Williams in the presence of us
