I Will of real and personal estate of John Haver testifies hereby that my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say

- 1 I Give to my son William Haver one certain piece or parcel of land which he is in possession of now lying on the north side of my home plantation to him and his heirs forever
- 2 I Give to my son Robert Haver all the mountain part of my home plantation likewise to have my home plantation at my wife's death by passing my son Thomas Haver four hundred dollars likewise
- 3 I Give to my son Robert Haver one half of my stock of hogs and one half of my flock of sheep to him and his heirs forever
- 4 I Give to my son James Haver the land he now lives on by him being at the expense of obtaining a title for said land to him and his heirs forever
- 5 I Give to my son John Haver the land he now lives on by him being at the expense of obtaining a title for said land to him and his heirs forever
- 6 I Give to my daughter Anna Band forty three dollars to be paid out of personal property to her and her heirs forever
- 7 I Give to my wife Sally Haver & daughter Nancy Haver & son Thomas Haver infant children the remaining part of my home plantation during my wife's natural life time likewise after my first debts and funeral expenses is paid I Give all my stock of horses cattle & one half of my hogs likewise my house hold and kitchen furniture also one half of the benefit of my shop or orchard likewise one wagon and blacksmith tools & all my farming tools to be divided equally between my son Robert Haver and my son Thomas Haver to them and their heirs forever
- 8 I Give to my son John Haver & Robert Haver executors of this my last will and testament hereby making all other or former wills or testaments null and void
