my last will and testament that is to say principally
and first of all I give and recommend
my soul unto the hands of a mighty God who
Save it and my body I recommend to the earth
to be buried in decent Christian burial at the
discretion of my executors nothing dubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive
wherewithal again by the mighty power of God
and as touching such worldly estate which comt
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life
I give devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner and form shewing
first of all settling debts and funeral expenses
leaving money to live out of my personal
property

2d I give and bequeath unto my well beloved son
William Hale one Negro Girl and her two boys (viz) their
names Loyda also one still and still tub also one bed
and its furniture also five head of hores all the
cattle except one that is to be hereafter deviced and
all the hogs also all the farming utensils also all
the grain that is now on said place where William
Hale lives and also all the household and kitchen
furniture also his herd of sheep

3d I also give and bequeath unto my well beloved
daughter wife McClaugherty one bed and its furniture

4th I also give and bequeath unto my well beloved
daughter Betty Williams Daughter of Margout
Bush Williams and Martha Ann Williams and all
the Girls if any there should be hereafter one Negro
Girl named Isabel the said Isabel is to be hired
or put with my daughter Betty Williams to
abstain herself the discretion of my executors if

hired the money to be put on interest for the benefit
of my grand daughters above mentioned also one bed
and its furniture.

5th And lastly I constitute make and obtain my friend
John McClaugherty Junr the sole executor of this my last will
and testament and do hereby entirely disallow every
discreional all and every other forms and testaments legacies
and Wills bequests and executors by one in any wise
before named will and bequeath the ratified and
confirmin this and no other take my last will & testam-
ent in witness whereof I have set my hand and

this 25th day of February 1837 and beg leave to submit the
following as the result of our Settlement your Commissioners
will further represent that it will be seen by the above
Settlement that we have given the Executor credit for an
Execution against George Powers and Archibald Chapman
it being for Costs sustained in defending a bill filed in the
Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery of Giles County
against the said William Chapman as Executor aforesaid which
we allow upon this Condition viz. that if upon a distribution
of the estate there shall be the amount of the said credit
due the said Powers and Archibald Chapman if there
should not be that amount due we then allow a credit
in proportion to the amount due the said George Chapman
Powers and Archibald Chapman your Commissioners will
further report that by a reference to the Settlement made
with the said Executor much prior to this it will be seen
that of 134,983⁴⁴ Cents was the sum upon which we reported
the Executor should be charged interest until paid
from which sum subtract \$62 the amount of a credit
which we have this day given him and which he claimed
at the last Settlement for expenses in transacting business
of the estate in the year 1816 leaves \$81,923⁴⁴ Cents the
