

from the 1st March 1831. also received the Lands of the said Mary Ann French the sum of \$200 due 1st March 1831 and also the sum of \$1.50 which appears to be all the estate of the said Mary Ann that came into the hands of her said Guardian as well more fully appear by reference to a settlement made and returned to the Clerk's Office of Giles County Court between the executors of the said William Wilson Decd and the Guardian of his three infant children as also by the several reports returned to the S^r Office by the said Guardian.

And on this day the said David Johnston produced receipts and Vouchers to the amount of \$175.58 cents which was admitted to be received by the said John Reed and was paid over to the said John Reed the sum of \$2855.81 1/2 cents in good Bonds well secured and also delivered to the said Reed the said's old Bonds Notes &c amounting to \$103.87 1/2 and there entered which said sum is in full pay for all the estate of the said ^{Mary Ann} French that have come into the hands of her said Guardian and the said John Reed paid over to the said David Johnston the sum of \$95.62 1/2 cents for his services as Guardian and each party executed clear receipts to the other and all the business fairly and finally closed given under my hand the 25th of April 1831 John M.
