weak of body but of perfect mind & memory think to
goe for his mercy & calling into mind the mortality
of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to die do make & declare this my last will
and Testament principally and first of all I give
and recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God
who gave it and my body I recommend to the Earth
to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the
discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
I shall receive it again by the mighty power of
God at the great and General resurrection of quick
and dead and as touching such worldly Estate as
with it hath pleased God to bless me with in
this life I give and dispose of the same in the
following manner and form to wit first I Give
and bequeath to my Son George Webb my mill
and land belonging thereto containing about thirty
acres partly to be possessed and enjoyed by him I also

one dollar and I do hereby give to my three sons

all my land in the County of Giles to them and their
heirs forever but the land to be for the use of the family
until the youngest of my Children comes of the age of
twenty one and then to be sold and equally divided among
my three sons viz William Christian & Levy Horsey Bant
and I do direct all my personal Estate to remain
in the hands of my beloved Wife viz Nancy Bant
until my youngest Child come to the age (or if she
should die before that period then my personal estate
to be equally divided among my five daughters viz
