Know all men by these presents that I Judah Farley
 of the County of Giles and State of Virginia for and
 in Consideration of the natural regard & maternal
 affection which I have for my daughter Judah
 Nicewonder And for and in Consideration of

the farther sum of two dollars to me in hand paid
 before the executing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have this
 day bargained and sold unto the said Judah
 Nicewonder and her heirs and assigns forever a
 negro man slave named Mingo about twenty
 years of age the title of said negro I do warrant
 and defend against me or my heirs or any claim-
 ing under through or by me or any claiming under
 or by the last will and Testament of Thomas
 Farley &c by which I the said Judah Farley
 acquired my title But it is expressly agreed and
 understood that the said Judah Farley is to retain
 the said negro man Mingo in her possession during
 the natural life of her the said Judah Farley &
 to have and enjoy the use and benefit of the
 labour of the said negro for the time aforesaid
 of her natural life, at which Period to come into
 the possession of the said Nicewonder And the
 said Nicewonder is to be at the rescue of the
 life of the said negro As Witness my hand &
 seal this 9th day of Septe 1809
