dollars in March 1833 which debt with its legal interest thereon
accruing is to be paid the said Ally J. Wadda is willing
and desirous to secure the said James Wadda the creditor the
amount above mentioned now this indenture witnessed therefor
and in consideration of the sum above mentioned hath given
granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed released and
confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain
sell alien convey release and confirm to the said James
Wadda trustee James Wadda and their heirs and assigns the
following property to wit one sorrel horse one brown mare
one waggon four pair of horns one bureau one chamber
and one cow and calf now of the said Ally J. Wadda with
pay and release the said James Wadda on or before the 22nd
of August 1832 then this indenture to be void or else remain
