as follows: forty dollars payable at the present instant five  
dollars in March 1832 five dollars in March 1833 and five  
dollars in March 1833 which debt with its legal interest thereon  
accruing is to be paid the said Alby J. Waddell is willing  
and desirous to secure the said James Waddell the creditor the  
amount above mentioned now this indenture witnesseth therefore  
and in consideration of the sum above mentioned hath given  
granted a bargained and sold aforesaid uncoffed release and  
confirmed and by these presents with give grant bargain  
and sell aforesaid release and confirmation to the said James  
Waddell and his heirs and assigns the  
following property to wit one sorrel horse one brown Mare  
one waggon four pair of horses one burean one chaise rug  
and one sofa and carpet now if the said Alby J. Waddell doth  
pay and release the said James Waddell on or before the 3<sup>rd</sup> day  
of August 1832 then this indenture to be void or else remain
