Fifty four Thomas Farley of Big Sugar Run County of Giles and State of Virginia being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do Settle and regulate to all my worldly affairs in this way and manner following
First I bequeath my Soul to God who gave it and my body to the worms Second it is my wish that my grave be Paled round and the expenses taken out of my Estate

Third all my legal Debts and funeral expenses are to be paid Fourth I bequeath to my Daughter Mahala Farley one dollar out of the Carding Machine

Fifth I bequeath to my Daughter Tursey Thompson one dollar Sixth I bequeath to my Son John C. Farley one dollar

Seventh I bequeath to my Daughter Judith C. Farley the plantation which I now reside with several other tracts joining to it containing in all about three hundred acres being more or less left the same which I deeded her half of out with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging this is to house the same at the death of her Mother with all the benefits arising therefrom also other property which I gave to her half of one hundred and her increased one hundred and one Cow and Calf and one two year old heifer also all the hogs and sheep which I now pay off one hundred and when giving one Bureau and six Windsor Chairs also one Copper Cattle at the death of her brother Eighth I bequeath to my Son Thomas Farley one dollar

Ninth I bequeath to my grand Daughter Judith Thompson Fifty dollars it is to be paid out of my estate

Tenth I bequeath to my grand Daughter Cleo Farley a small tract of land about 15 acres on which Tom Meadow formerly lived joining Edward Eaton plantation also another tract of land joining to the North side of Walker Creek beginning on a corner of John Hammillins on the North side of a hill and running thence N 30 E 90 P to two white oak saplings on the North side of hill thence E 74 P and from that an open line to the beginning also about 15 acres joining to it of an inclusive Survey I bought of Samuel Eleventh I bequeath to my grand Son John Farley the plantation on which his father now lives containing about 300 acres also the Smith Tools which his father now has in possession Twelfth I bequeath to my grand son John Farley Farley a plantation on the East side of Walker Creek containing about 103 acres

of what disposed of otherwise in my lifetime and nothing I do
constitute and affaint either Shannon or Cox etc to this day last.

that it hath pleased God to help me with, I do dispose of in manner and
form of alluring he with First I give and bequeath unto my well beloved
wife Mary Atkins my home plantation where I now reside houses and kitchen
and all that belongs in the house where I now dwell and the kitchen furniture
and two black boy Ned and Lewis and one Huzzler girl name
Emma line of our head of house one Serval man about six years old and
some horse pack one Serval horse day one big horse Charley four with
each choice of the flock and ten head of Sheep choice of the flock
and twenty head of hog and two black hounds and this money before
and way in two double tree one pair of Sheeves and fifth board and
all the Gads and Silvers that I have in my possession Mary my wife is
to give each of my daughter Savannah to my self and Michael one
cow and calf each at the worth of them when married and one Bed
and furniture equal to those that have married and each of the boys the
same when married and also Susannah my daughter is to live with
my wife so long as my wife lives if she pleases to do so if she continues
single Secondly I give and bequeath to my eldest son Kornel the place
where he now lives ten of his Land in my estate of Land amount to one
thousand dollars when all my estate of Land is finally settled if my
Land is not sufficient to make all my sons one thousand dollars
that get the Land to that amount shall pay those that do not get that amount
in Land make all my sons equal and all my Land is to be released if they
cannot agree within themselves and each of my sons is to take the Land
at its valuation and Thirdly I give and bequeath to my son Tom and
Lewis each to have one forty foot lot of land after the death of my wife
or the value Fourthly I give to my son Kornel black house called Nipper
Fifthly I give to my son Williams one two year old mow full bushy
Sixthly I give to my son Moses one Serval man that he bought of Wright and sons
Rifles gun Seventhly I give to my daughter Savannah three hundred and
fifty dollars in Money my daughter Nancy I give and bequeath three hundred and
fifty dollars in Money also I give and bequeath to my daughter three hundred and
fifty dollars in Money all the rest of my Estate real and personal
