The last will and testament of Benjamin Rowe ^{sr} of Gloucester County.

I bequeath to my wife Margaret H. Rowe of the Shira and Glap wars,
I also give her all my furniture and one bed with necessary covering
I also give her my waggon, one Horse & one cow,

I also bequeath to my wife Margaret H. Rowe one third of my real
estate so long as she remains my widow with the dwelling House, at her
death it is to be divided equally between his heirs at law.

I bequeath to the children of my daughter Elizabeth the wife of William C
Brooks one fourth of my real estate after giving my widow her third.

I bequeath to my daughter Cornelia the wife of Benjamin A. Rowe one fourth
of my real estate after giving my widow her third. I bequeath to the children
of my son Benjamin T. Rowe one fourth of my real estate after giving my
widow her third. I bequeath to the child of my son Jasper Rowe one
fourth of my real estate after giving my wife her third. My stock

consisting of one Horse three cows and two Yearling are to be sold to
pay my debts, I also leave one Bond of James H. Davis to be collected to
pay my debts. I also make Benjamin A. Rowe my Executor having
full confidence that he will conduct the affairs of my Estate honestly,
I do not want the Court to exact any security from him this 18th day
of October 1886
