Will

In the name of God Amen: I Charles Patterson of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being in my right mind and memory do make this my last will and testament that is to say, my desire is to be buried with as little expence as decency will permit and that my funeral expences to be paid as soon after my decease as conveniently may be, And I give and devise to my wife Sarah C. Patterson her life time or so long as she remains my widow, the house in which I now live and six acres of land and at the death or remarriage of my wife Sarah C. Patterson, I give and devise the said six acres of land and the house and improvements to my three grand children Florence Patterson, Robert Patterson and Charles Dorel Patterson to be divided equally among them. And I give and devise the rest of my land containing six acres to Nancy A. Patterson, Anna V. Patterson, Mary J. Dickson, Simon Patterson and Cora Lee Patterson to be equally divided among them.

And I give and devise to my sons Charles H. Patterson, B. F. Patterson and Feeling Patterson all of my carpenter's tools and one of a oak to be equally divided among them. And I nominate and appoint my son Feeling Patterson executor of this my last will.

On the qualification of my son Feeling as executor of this my will, I request and direct that no security be required of him.
