Wills

On this the 23rd day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one. I Daniel Allen of the County of Gloucester State of Virginia do make this my last will and testament. I give to my wife Rhoda all of my personal property. I give to my wife Rhoda during her life the tract of land on which I reside. containing thirteen and four fifths acres. At the death of my wife Rhoda I give this same tract to my niece Julia Ann Hacker. (who, when I last heard from her lived in Carroll County Georgia) if she be then alive. If my niece be dead at the time of my wife's death I give this same tract of land to her lawful heirs.
