First - I direct That all of my just debts shall be

and bequeath all of my said Estate both real and

Fourth - I desire That my said sister Eliza Booth Mason  
may be appointed Guardian of my said child Elizabeth  
Booth Han, and I most respectfully request the Court  
That no security shall be required of her as such  
Guardian, I do this having implicit confidence  
in my said sister and believing That my said  
sister will do all in her power for the interest  
of my said child -
