2^d. I leave my wife Sarah A. Thurston my executrix without security to manage to suit herself. As witness my hand and seal this 8th day of August (1872) eighteen hundred and Seventy two.

Heywood being duly sworn deposed that he is well acquainted with the handwriting of the Testator and verily believe that the said will and signature thereto subscribed is wholly written by the Testator's own hand whereupon the said will was ordered to be recorded as the true last will and Testament of Emanuel J. Thurston died and is recorded.
