Item first- I leave all the property or my portion that is owned between me and my two sisters Sarah & Rachel Smith, both personal & real estate & also my portion of the widow's dower of my Father estate to the said Sarah & Rachel Smith during their natural lives.

2nd Item. I give the said property to Armistead Smith my Brother, if the said Armistead Smith should be dead before he has the said property, I give the same to his children living equally, this 2 day February 1850.
