and State of Virginia being of Sound and disposing mind and  
memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament  
Item 1<sup>st</sup> I desire that my Executors hereinafter named shall pay  
off and fully discharge all my just debts with the money that  
shall come first into their hands. Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my Son Tho<sup>s</sup>  
R. Wallington and his heirs forever one half of all my estate whether  
real or personal. Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I lend to my daughter Nancy Corr the wife  
of Levi P. Corr the other half of my estate whether real or personal  
for and during her natural life. But should my daughter Nancy  
Corr die without lawful issue living at the time of her death. I give  
to my Son Thomas R. Wallington all the estate both real and per-  
sonal herebefore lent to her for and during her natural life.  
Item 4<sup>th</sup> at the death of my daughter Nancy Corr I give to her  
child or children then living the estate both real and personal  
herebefore lent to her for and during her natural life but  
should any one or more of her said children die before arriving  
at the age of twenty one or marrying then and in that case  
I give his or her share to the surviving brother or brother  
Sister or Sisters to them and to their heirs forever  
Item 5<sup>th</sup> I hereby constitute and appoint my Son Tho<sup>s</sup> R. Wat-  
lington and my Son-in-law Levi P. Corr Executors to this my  
last will and Testament

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I hereby constitute and appoint my son Thos R Wallington and my son-in-law Levi P Carr Executors to this my last will and testament.
