I Francis A Jacksonman of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia do
make and ordain this to be my last will and testament as follows
I wish all my just debts to be paid and Mr Augustus S. Fawcett to be fully com-
pensated for his attention and kindness to me

I give to my friend James B. Smith one equal third part of my estate, both real
and personal on account of his honesty and faithfulness of character, and the re-
-aining two thirds of my estate, I give to Susan J. Roane, widow of Spencer Roane
and daughter of William F. and Lucy B. Adams and to Elizabeth Rebecca Keels
another daughter of the said William F. and Lucy B. Adams to be equally div-
-ided between them the said Susan J. Roane and Elizabeth Rebecca Keels
I nominate and appoint James B. Smith and William F. Adams to carry into
effect the provisions of this my last will and testament February 15th 1861
