Know all men by these presents that I George Washington Brown of Gloucester

out of my personal estate as soon after my decease as shall be found convenient
by my executor.

I give I give unto Mr. Elizabeth that five barrels of corn two bags and ten
dollars worth of Irish potatoes and all the fruit of every description upon the yard
and two muddings of Bacon.

I give and bequeath unto George Brown son of John Brown my light saddle
coat. And the remainder of all growing crops.

I give unto John Brown son of George W Brown my horse and wagon and
shoe and cart. And the balance of my estate both real and personal
I desire after my funeral expenses and just debts and pious to be equally
divided among my children.

my last will and testament contained no no half sheet of Paper I have

Jr. Mr. Shockefer. Stephen Hegg. Mr. Hegg, & Master Hegg are appointed appraisers
of the said Estate and the said will is recorded.
