In the name of God. Amen. I Henry M. More of the county of Gloucester, State of Virginia do make and declare this my last will and Testament, as follows. I give to my wife Caroline E. More during her natural life or so long as she shall remain my widow, all my property, both real and personal to be kept together for the use and benefit of herself and our children Cora S. L. More, Etha J. More and Martin L. More. At the death or marriage of my said wife I desire that what remains of my estate be divided amongst my five children equally, with the following exception, to wit, I give to my son Henry L. More and to my daughter Cora S. L. More and Etha J. More each fifty (50) dollars. Also in the division of my estate then to my sons Christopher L. More and Martin L. More, because I have already herebefore given to the two last mentioned sons each a bequest valued at fifty (50) dollars. In witness whereof, I the said testator hereunto set my hand, and seal this the 7th day of November 1892
