taining one hundred fifteen acres it being a portion of the tract called

same to be equal as the above for the rents.

3 Give to my daughter Mary T Roane one hundred and fifteen
acres of land known as Foxes where Ricard H Roane now live
and as laid down on plot the same equally as the above for the
rents.

4 I give to my daughter Virginia A Merridith one hundred and
fifteen acres of land known as Genges the same equal as the

above for the rents.
