In the name of God. Amen. I John H. P. Seawell of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia. being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament. this Eight day of April 1889 hereby revoking all former wills and testaments heretofore by me at any time made. My will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid by my Executor hereinafter named as soon after my death as shall be by him to deemed convenient. I give and bequeath unto my wife, Mary H. Seawell, all the real and personal property, after the payment of the debts and expenses heretofore mentioned, of which I shall die, to have and to hold the same during her natural life - I give, devise and bequeath to my son John H. P. Seawell that portion of land lying on "Sims Creek" Creek including the house and running the dividing line North and South; Douchester Co. Virginia Wills 1862-1896 www.virginiapioneers.net Each of my two Children. Namely; the above mentioned John H. P. Seawell, and Ann M. Froque to have each an Equal number of acres of land to their sole use and behoof. The said division to take place at the death of their mother the said Mary H. Seawell. Lastly:

I do nominate and appoint my son John H. P. Seawell to be my the Executor of this my last will and testament and that he shall not be required to give bond as said Executor.

In testimony whereof I the said John H. P. Seawell have to this my last will and testament. Contained on one sheet of paper subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 8th day of April 1889.
