I John H Walker of the County of Henrico and State of Virginia, being of sound
Mind and Memory and Considering the uncertainty of this mortal life do make this my
last will and testament in manner and form following: My
First I give and bequeath unto my grand children Mary Jane Riles, John H Walker
Virginia Walker and Richard Amos Walker, the Feather bed and furniture
Secondly I leave to my son John Walker during his life the Feather bed and furniture
at his death I give and bequeath the said bed and furniture to his children
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my grand son George T Walker the Feather bed and furniture
Fourthly I direct my Executor herein after named to sell the residue of my printable pro=
perty and also my real estate and out of the proceeds arising therefrom after paying
my funeral expenses and all of my just and honorable debts, I direct my executor to
pay to my daughter Charlotte Riles the sum of Ten dol=
lars and I further direct my executor to pay to my son Elijah Walker the sum of Eight
dollars in money, the balance of the funds I wish and desire to be divided into Six
equal parts and from one of the said Shares, I direct my executor to deduct the sum
of Seventy three dollars and thirty cents, should the said Shares amount to that
amount and the said Seventy three dollars and thirty cents, I wish equally applied
to the other five Shares to be disposed of as follows: one of the said five Shares I leave
to my daughter Mary A Riles during her life at her death I give the same to her lawful heirs
one of the said Shares I leave to my son Elijah Walker during his life at his death I give
the same to his lawful heirs, one of the said Shares I leave to my son George Walker dur=
ing his life at his death I give the same to his lawful heirs, one of the said Shares I give
and bequeath unto my grand children Mary Jane Riles, John H Walker, Virginia
Walker and Richard A Walker. The remainder of the sixth share I leave my son John
Walker during his life at his death I give the same to his lawful heirs

and five shares I leave to my daughter Charlotte Riles
one of the said five shares I give the same to her
heirs

A one of the said five shares I lend to my daughter Charlotte Kiler during her life and at her death I give the same to her lawful heirs

Secondly I leave to my son John Walker during his life one Feather Bed and furniture at his death I give and bequeath the said bed and furniture to his children
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my grandson George J Walker one Feather Bed and furniture
Fourthly I direct my Executor herein after named to sell the residue of my personal property and also my real estate and out of the proceeds arising therefrom after paying my funeral expenses and all of my just and honorable debts, I direct my executor to pay to my daughter Charlotte Kiler for her kindred's attention to me the sum of Ten dollars and I further direct my executor to pay to my son Elijah Walker the sum of Eight dollars in money, the ballance of the funds I wish and desire to be divided into Six equal parts and from one of the said Shares, I direct my executor to deduct the sum of Seventy three dollars and thirty cents, should the said Shares amount to that amount and the said Seventy three dollars and thirty cents, I wish equally applied to the other five Shares to be disposed of as follows, one of the said five Shares I lend to my daughter Mary Kiler during her life at her death I give the same to her lawful heirs one of the said Shares I lend to my son Elijah Walker during his life at his death I give the same to his lawful heirs, one of the said Shares I lend to my son George Walker during his life at his death I give the same to his lawful heirs, one of the said Shares I give and bequeath unto my grand children Mary Jane Kiler, John W Walker, Virginia Walker and Richard A Walker. The remainder of the sixth Share I lend my son John Walker during his life at his death I give the same to his lawful heirs. In event of their not being funds enough in my Executors hands to create Six Shares of Seventy three dollars and thirty cents to a Share, then in that event I direct my Executor to divide the said amount in five Shares and pay and dispose of the same as first specified. I direct my Executor in making sale of real estate to observe the grave yard and in case of land trusts attached. Lastly I do hereby constitute and
