publish and declare this to be my last will and Testament.

and bequeath and dispose of as follows.

To my beloved wife the farm on which I now reside, with
all the appurtenances situated thereon to hold and enjoy dur-
ing her natural life, and at her death I give and bequeath
to my daughter Sarah the Homestead with all the buildings
and appurtenances thereto belonging with as much land
attached as shall render it equal in value to the shares of
my other two children Susan and India, the same to be
used and enjoyed by her during her natural life, and at her
death to go to her children and their heirs forever. In wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and
affixed my seal this 16th day of March 1882
