In the name of God amen. I Letty R. Hibble of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being of sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this as and for my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit. In the first place I desire that all my just debts to be paid. Secondly, I give and bequeath to my son Geo J. Hibble the piece of land Called Whittings containing about one hundred and Six acres to him and his heirs forever. Thirdly, I desire that my Son Wm J. Shift shall have 1 Bureau 1 Bedstead 1 Dressing Table and five chairs. The balance of perishable property I wish sold for the payment of my debts. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19th day of April 1872
