Mack Freeman

In the Name of God Amen, I Mack Freeman of the county of Lincoln in the state of Virginia, former being weak in body and of sound mind, memory, and understanding, but considering the uncertainties of this transitory life, do make this my last will and testament, in manner and form following to wit:

And lastly, I nominate, constitute and appoint my said daughter Williamina Robinson and my grandson Christoph Freeman, to be the executors of this my will hereby revoking all other wills, bequests, and legacies, by me hitherto made, and declaring this, and no other, to be my last will and Testament.
