calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make
and constitute this my last will and testament in words and figures as follows
1st I wish my representatives hereafter named at my death to pay all my just debts
punctually. 2nd At my death I give and bequeath to my adopted daughter
Martha Columbus Lowry all my estate both real and personal of every kind
and description, but in the event of her departing this life without being married
or having a lawful heir or heirs, then in that case I wish what remains un-
-intended to go to the children of my relation George Washington Gibbons
3rd I constitute and appoint my friends
