

Will of L. E. Folkes

I Will and bequeath to my Husband R. A. Folkes
My portion of my Mother's estate located in New Kent
Co Va to have and to hold without let or hindrance

July 9th 1895

At a County Court begun and held for Gloucester County at
the Court House on Monday the 4th day of April 1898

A writing purporting
to be the last Will and Testament of Mrs L. E. Folkes deceased
was this day produced in Court and thus being no sub-
scribing witnesses thereunto. Mary A. Folkes daughter of the
decedent was sworn and deposed that she was well
acquainted with the handwriting of the Testatrix
and truly believed that the said handwriting and
the names subscribed thereunto be wholly written by
the own hand of said Testatrix. Whereupon the said
writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last Will
and Testament of the said L. E. Folkes deceased
and on Motion of R. A. Folkes Husband of the decedent
and sole heir under said Will he is allowed to qual-
ify as administrator of the said decedent's estate with
the said Will annexed and certification is made to him

The Court House on Monday the 4th day of April 1898

A writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Mrs L. E. Folkes deceased was this day produced in Court and thus being no subscribing witness thereto. Mary A. Folkes daughter of the decedent was sworn and deposed that she was well acquainted with the hand writing of the Testatrix and truly believed that the said handwriting and the name subscribed thereto to be wholly written by the own hand of said Testatrix. Whereupon the said writing is ordered to be received as the true last Will and Testament of the said L. E. Folkes deceased and on Motion of R. A. Folkes Husband of the decedent and sole heir under said Will he is allowed to qualify as administrator of the said decedent's estate with the said Will annexed, and Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on said estate C. T. A. in due form without security or giving bond as such administrator and is recorded.
