The last will of me, Nancy Foxwell of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being of sound mind at the time of making and publishing this my last will and testament - That is to say I give and bequeath - First To my youngest Child, Anna Webb with whom I am living; all my Hogg, Bed Bolster Pillows Sheets and Covering my House and four acres of Cleared land with and about the house and one acre of timbered or woods land to be bounded on the South and West by Mr Heywoods lands; Second To my married daughter Susan Dudley three and a half acres of Cleared land and a half acre of timbered land joining my daughter Anna's.

Third. The remainder of my land which I supposed to be thirteen acres, to my sons, John George and Solomon Foxwell; and my daughter Sarah Hogg, to be equally divided between them giving to each of them that has a house, his or her share with and about the house; and.

Fourth. That the land may be peaceably divided as above bequeathed, I appoint and request my friend Mr William R. Heywood to decide how and where each and every line shall be run. In witness whereof, I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my Seal the twenty sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six.
