First: It is my wish and desire that as soon after my death as practicable that all of my just and lawful debts be paid out of any monies belonging to my Estate.

Secondly the residue of my Estate after the payment of my debts both real and personal consisting of the tract land whereon I reside one horse one Wagon of Oxen, Hens, and Kitchen furniture, Hogs Farming Implements Crops, &c I give and bequeath to N. K. Dutton.

Thirdly and lastly I nominate and appoint my friend A. F. Dutton Executor of this my last will and testament and direct that the County Court will not require of him any security on his executory bond on my Estate. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of June 1880
