In the Name of God Amen. I Robin Gayle of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being of Sound and disposing Mind and Memory and considering the uncertainty of this Mortal life do make and ordain This to be My last Will and Testament in Manner and form following to Wit: First- It is my wish and desire as soon after My death as may be practicable and convenient That My funeral expenses and ~~any~~ just debts That I may owe be paid out of any funds belonging to My Estate.

Should there be any residue of My personal Estate after the pay of My funeral expenses and just debts I give and bequeath the same to My daughter Sarah J. Gayle.
