uncertainty of this mortal life do make and ordain this my last will and tes-
tament in manner and form following (that is to say).

First, It is my wish and desire, that my body may be buried with as
little expense as necessary and at the direction of my executor herein-
after named and as soon as practicable after my death that all of
my funeral expenses and just debts be paid out of any funds be-
longing to my estate.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Minnie A
Enos to make her equal with my sons Wm. L. Enos and John T
Enos The following named articles of personal property to wit, one
Young bay horse called Hampton, one Cow, 1 set Chamber furniture
including one feather Bedstead and all necessary covering for
same, one extra feather bedstead and necessary covering for same,
one Sewing machine, one Piano and fixtures and one Turkey
Carpet for her own absolute use & benefit.

Thirdly. The residue of my personal property to wit, three cows
one calf, one Rockaway, one set harness, one single barrel gun,
I wish and desire to be sold and the money arising therefrom
after paying my funeral expenses and debts hereinbefore men-
tioned to be equally divided between my three children, Wm. L.
Enos, John T Enos and Minnie A. Enos share and share alike.

Fourthly. I nominate and appoint my son Wm. L. Enos executor
of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th day of October 1882
