To my said husband Thomas C Paytop I give and bequeath all the personal property now held by James C Paytop trustee under a deed of trust heretofore executed and recorded in the Clerk's office of Gloucester County, but which has been destroyed by fire in the year 1865 with the other records of said office. To my said husband I devise all the real estate held by said trustee J C Paytop under the aforesaid deed of trust unto him my said husband & his heirs forever the said deed vesting in me the power to dispose of said real and personal property which I now hereby exercise. I hereby appoint my said husband my Executor and as I owe no debts it is my request that the Court in which he shall prove this will shall not require and security of him as my Executor. In testimony of all which I have set my hand and Seal this 12th day of December 1868
