

Will of Susan Daniel

I Susan Daniel of the County of Gloucester State of Virginia being of Sound Mind and Memory do Make and Publish This My last Will and Testament This Sixteenth day of November 1896.

I give and bequeath to My daughter Susan Ann Paul for the term of her Natural life, two acres (2) of My land situate on Wilson Creek to have and to hold the same for her Natural life and at her death to her children in fee -

The said two acres to be cut off my said tract, on the side adjoining Brooks Whiting's land -

To My daughter Elizabeth Taggart I give and bequeath two acres (2) of said land for the term of her Natural life and at her death to her children in fee -

The said two acres to be laid off next to the land bequeathed to Susan Ann Paul -

To My daughter Harriet Dennis I give and bequeath two acres of said land for the term of her Natural life and at her death to her children in fee -

The said two acres to be laid off next to the land hereby bequeathed to Elizabeth Taggart -

In cutting off the three tracts of land hereby bequeathed the lines are to run straight across ⁱⁿ parallel lines -

All the residue of my said tract of land I give and

with cutting off the three tracts of land hereby bequeathed
The lines are to run straight across ⁱⁿ parallel lines.

All the residue of my said tract of land I give and
bequeath for the term of his natural life to my son Gil-
bert Daniel and at his death to his children born to him
in lawful wedlock in fee.
