I Thomas T Wiatt of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being fully aware of the uncertainty of life, especially with one of my advanced age, and infirm health do make this my last will and Testament, revoking all other wills and Testaments, that is to say, I appoint my nephew, Doctor Walker & Jones my sole Executor, and having perfect confidence in my said appointed Executor, it is my desire that he shall not be required to give security for his administration.

It is my will that my Executor pay to William my former servant, one hundred dollars, out of any money found which may come into his hands, as a remuneration for his services and other considerations, since the Government at Washington thought proper to make him a free man.

After the above mention legacy and my just debts are paid, for and in consideration of the many kind attentions, which I have received at the hands of Doctor Walker & Jones and his amiable wife, both professional and otherwise, I give and bequeath, to the said Walter & Jones, the residue of all my property of every kind and description including my Virginia Bonds, my City of Norfolk Bonds, my Rail Road Shares dividend, Bonds and all debt and money which may be due me.

Witness, signed and sealed with my own hand, this the Twentyfirst day of September Eighteen hundred and Sixty six.

At a Court held for Gloucester County at the Courthouse on Monday the 1st day of January 1866, this last will and Testament of Thomas T Wiatt deceased, ^{as produced in Court for proof} and there being no subscribing witnesses to the same, Charles W. Montague and Wm ap W Jones were sworn and severally deposed that they are well acquainted with the handwriting of the said Thomas T Wiatt deceased and verily believe that the said Will and the signature thereto^{are} wholly in the proper handwriting of the said Thomas T. Wiatt, whereupon the same was ordered to be recorded as the true last will and Testament of the said Thomas T. Wiatt deceased and is recorded
