

Willis Perren's
"Will"

In the name of God amen. I Willis Perren of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia being of sound mind &c do make and declare the following to be my last Will and testament revoking all other Wills heretofore made by me. First I give and bequeath to my brother Wm K. Perren all the land of which I may be possessed to him and his heirs forever, and in the event of my brother dying before I do so as to cause what the law calls a lapse legacy then and then in case I give the said land to all the children of my said brother who may be living at the time of my death to them and their heirs forever. Secondly. It is my Will and desire that all my negro Slaves and all my other personal property be equally divided between my ~~brother~~ Joseph James Kinnon Dobney and all the children of my brother William K Perren.

Thirdly. It is my Will and desire that my Executor raise out of all my estate both real and personal the sum of two thousand dollars to be by him disposed of in the following manner Viz. my Will and desire is that my Executor hereafter named pay over to the regular qualified Guardian of the ^{all} children of my niece Rebecca Seawell wife of (Benjamin Seawell Esq) the sum of one thousand dollars to be held by said guardian for the separate use and benefit of said children & the remaining thousand I desire shall be paid to my friend Richard M Thornton of the State of Mississippi.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath to Mr John Kemp my hot spur horse Saddle and bridle, and lastly I do hereby appoint & constitute my brother William K Perren Executor to this my last will and

brother William H. Perrin.

Thirdly. It is my Will and desire that my Executor raise out of all my estate both real and personal the sum of two thousand dollars to be by him disposed of in the following manner Viz my Will and desire is, that my Executor hereinafter named pay over to the regular qualified Guardian of the ^{and} Children of my niece Rebecca Seawell wife of Benjamin Seawell Esq the sum of one thousand dollars to be held by said guardian for the separate use and benefit of said Children & the remaining thousand I desire shall be paid to my friend Richard M. Thurston of the State of Mississippi.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath to Mr John Kemp my hot spur horse Saddle and bridle, and lastly, I do hereby appoint & constitute my brother William H. Perrin Executor to this my last will and Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 23rd day of October 1837
