last illness. 2nd At the death of my wife I give and bequeath to my
Son in law Claiborne J. Roane all the remainder of my estate real and
personal. 3rd I reserve half acre of land around the grave yard, and a
road fifteen feet wide from the said grave yard to the main road lead-
ing to Gloucester Courthouse. 4th I hereby appoint my Son in law
Claiborne J. Roane my executor to this my last Will and Testament.

my last Will and Testament signed and subscribed my name this
11th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
dred and Sixty.

son in law Claiborne J. Roane all the remainder of my estate real and
personal. 3rd I reserve half acre of land around the grave yard, and a
road fifteen feet wide from the said grave yard to the main road lea-
ding to Gloucester Courthouse - and I herein appoint my son in law
Claiborne J. Roane my executor to this my last will and testament.

At a County Court held for Gloucester County at the Court house on Monday the 7th day of May 1870. This last Will and Testament of William Chapman deceased was proved in open Court by the oath of Thomas C. Cooke one of the witnesses subscribed to the body of the Will and the Codicil thereto was proved by the oath of George E. Shackelford one of the witnesses thereto subscribed and continued for further proof. And at a Court of quarterly session begun and held for Gloucester County at the Court house on Monday the 6th day of June 1870 the said Will was further proved by the oath of N. D. Cooke the other witness thereto subscribed and the Codicil thereto was further proved by the oath of A. C. Lambuth the other subscribing witness to the same whereupon the said Will and Codicil thereto were ordered to be recorded and are recorded—
