make and declare this my last will and Testament.
First I desire and direct my Executor hereafter to be named to pay off and
discharge all my just debts of which at this time I have few or none.
Second. As I have hitherto from time to time as I thought their interest re-
quired, advanced my children providing for them by various settlements, by
paying off debts they or their husbands had contracted, and by conveyances
and gifts of real and personal estate, and as in so doing I have acted
in a manner which was well considered and which is now entirely sat-
isfactory to me and which I now approve and confirm, and with
which I think my children have no cause to be dissatisfied, and
as I believe I have made sufficient provision heretofore for all of
them except those now to be named for whom I desire to make a
further provision, it is my will and desire that whatever property I
shall leave undisposed of at my death otherwise than by this will
shall be divided into four equal parts in value and I give and
bequeath to my daughter Julia Walker two parts thereof, to my
daughter Virginia E. Heywood one part thereof and to my daughter

Emeline M. Leitchin, the remaining one part thereof, but if any of my said daughters should die before me then and in that event I desire that the children of any so dying shall have the part and share of my estate hereby devised to their mother or mothers.

If no competent and satisfactory division of my property can be made in kind as above directed, then I direct my executor to make sale of the property and collect such debts as may be due me and distribute the proceeds thereof in the proportions above directed to my above named daughters or their children as the case may be.

I have made no provision for my wife in this my will, and it is therefore proper to state that my daughter Emeline and her husband John Leitchin have promised to take care of and provide amply for her wants during her life should she survive me and I and my wife both feel full confidence in the affection of our daughter Emeline and her husband and are satisfied that they will fully perform their promise.
