

In the Name of God Amen. I Abram Parkins of Saint James's Parish in Gooch
Land County being in perfect sense and memory, but calling to mind the mor-
tality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die and know-
ing not how soon it may please God to take me out of this transitory life, do
make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following, viz; Principally and first of all I give and bequeath my Soul
to God that gave it me and my body to the Earth from whence it came to
be buried in a Christian like form, nothing doubting but at the generall
Resurrection shall receive the same again by the Almighty power of God,
and as touching my worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me with in this life with I devise and dispose of the same in the following
manner and form.

Item I give and bequeath unto Abram Parkins all my land with the bounds and
appurtenances therunto belonging.

Item I give and bequeath unto Abram Parrish my Negro Girl Effey and all
her increase forever, but if in case the said Abram Parrish should die
without heirs of body lawfully begotten then my donee is Abram Parkins
shall have her with all her increase for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto Constant Good the feather bed and furniture
belonging to it that I now lie on to him forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Abram Parkin my Negro Girl Effey and all her increase forever. But if in case the said Abram Parkin should die without heirs of body lawfully begotten then my desire is Abram Parkin shall have her with all her increase for ever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Constant Lead the feather bed and furniture belonging to it that I now lie on to him forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Sarah Alcorn One cow with calf.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Sarah Parkin One cow with calf.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Richard Parkin Esq. One black Stear named Wiggson with her increase forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto John Parkin One riding large Table.

Item. I give and bequeath unto David Howling One Iron Pott.

Item. I give and bequeath all the rest of my estate that can be found both within doors and without unto Abram Parkin forever.

Item. I do also Appoint Phillomen Parkin and his son Abram Parkin to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 17th day of January 1723

This Will was proved by the Oaths of the Witnesses hereto and was Ordered to be Recorded.

In the Name of God Amen. I Rob^t Atkinson of the Parish of St. James's in the County of Goochland being very sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I commend my Soul to God and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried according to the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as to what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with, after my Debts and several Charges are paid and Defrayd, I give and Dispose of as followeth.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anne Atkinson two Negroes which I was to have of John Payne for my Ferry and Land to her and her heirs forever. And as to all my other Estate I give to my loving Wife Elizabeth Atkinson during her Natural life and after her decease to assign to my Daughter Anne Atkinson. And I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving Wife Elizabeth Atkinson and my well beloved Son Charles
