to be Leaved out of my Estate the above mentioned Land and
more I give to my Daughter Carolina for her and her heirs forever.

the above and give three hundred and twenty acres of Land to
my Beloved Wife Sarah Rabus for her use and the use of her heirs

Item I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Sarah Rabus
a Negro girl named Jane with all the Remainder of my Estate Land
I prepted for her and her heirs for ever.

Item I do constitute and Appoint my Beloved Wife Sarah Rabus to be my
whole and sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament I do hereby
declare this and none other to be my last Will and Testament Rescinding all
other Wills and Testaments I did make and have been by me made

Day of February one thousand seven hundred and forty three
