This Indenture made the Twenty sixth Day of February in the Year of
our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred and forty six By & between Charles
Anderson of Southam Parish in Goochland County of the one part & William Watson
of the Parish & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Charles Anderson for in Consideration of the Sum of Twenty pounds Curr. Money
to him in hand paid by the said Wm Watson at & before the In sealing & Delivering
of these Presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof every part
thereof doth clearly Acquitt & discharge the said William Watson his heirs Executors
& Adm^{rs} & every of them by these Presents. Hath given granted
