that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my
presant last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all
I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave
it And for my Body I commend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like
and decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the last general Resurrection I shall receive the same I gave by
the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estates where with
it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and Dispose of the
same in the following manner and from first I would that all my debts
and funeral Charges be paid. Item. I give and bequeath to my Son David
Parrish all my lands that lies on the West side the branch in the S. David
River on that Runn through my land which contains forty Acres more
or less. Likewise I give all the Rest of my Estate to my Wife Mary Parrish
during her life then at her decease I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Mary Parrish all my Estate whom I likewise constitute my only whole
Executors of this my last Will and Testament. I do hereby utterly disavow

At a Court held for Goochland County June 21. 1743.

This Will was proved by the Oaths of the Witnesses here to to be the last Will and Testament of Humphry Parrish deceased which was ordered to be Recorded.

To all Christian people to whom these presents shall come greeting I know ye that we William Woodson and James Daniel of Goochland County having jointly taken up and patented in our names one tract of land containing four hundred acres lying on the South Side James River on a branch of Miller's Creek falls oak and have caused the same to be divided in two equal parts by a line drawn from a former gum on the line of Col^o William Mayo and the course thereof South thirty four and an half degrees East running through and Equally dividing the said tract wth division we desire may be recorded.
