River of Delate River between Flowers's and Stevans's lines to him and
his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Son William Lasly One Entry of
Land in Albemarle County containing four hundred Acres upon the Moun-
tain Fork of Slait River to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Son Robert Lasly One Entry of
Land in Albemarle County containing four hundred Acres on the main fork
of Delate River to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Son Willinton Lasly One Entry

of Land in Albemarle County containing four hundred Acres on Jones's
East side the South side State River to him and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith Esly my Negro
man ^{no} Will.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Joyce Esly my Horse
Snoaker and her Saddle and Bridle I also give her the use of a Negro
Woman named Samiah and at her Death to Return to my Daughter
Judith.

My Will is that all the Rest of my Estate shall be raised and Sold
and after my Debts are paid the Remainder to be Equally Divided
between my loving Wife and Children and I appoint Candy Walker
and James Barnes Executors of this my last Will and Testament Wit-
ness my hand and Seal this fourth day of One thousand Seven hun-
dred and forty six
